

Government Decree 45/2020 (14 March)

on the measures to be taken during the state of danger declared for the prevention of the human epidemic endangering life and property and causing massive disease outbreaks, for the elimination of its consequences, and for the protection of the health and lives of Hungarian citizens (II)

The Government
acting within its original legislative power laid down in Article 53(2) of the Fundamental Law,
having regard, for section 1, to the proposal from the President of the Curia, the President of the National Office for the Judiciary and the Prosecutor General,
acting within its functions laid down in Article 15(1) of the Fundamental Law,
orders as follows:

1. Rules on epidemiological isolation, observation, quarantine and monitoring ordered for the prevention of the introduction or spread of an infectious disease subject to compulsory quarantine

Section 1 On a proposal from the President of the Curia, the President of the National Office for the Judiciary and the Prosecutor General, extraordinary court vacation shall be ordered

Section 2 (1) The mayor of the settlement local government, or in the case of the capital, the mayor of the district, of the institution providing nursery services or of the kindergarten (hereinafter jointly “mayor”) may order extraordinary break for institutions providing nursery or kindergarten services. The mayor shall, as a matter of priority, notify the Minister for Human Capacities of ordering a break.

2. Extraordinary measures

Section 3 (1) If the period of the registration of a healthcare worker in the operational register (hereinafter “registration”) referred to in section 113 (1) of Act CLIV of 1997 on healthcare expires during the period of the state of danger, upon the entry into force of this Decree, the expiry period of registration shall be extended until the 90th day following the end of the state of danger.

(2) During the extended period of registration, as provided for in paragraph (1), the performance of healthcare activities shall not be suspended.

3. Final provisions

Section 4 (1) This Decree shall enter into force on the day following its promulgation.

(2) The provisions of subtitle 2 shall apply also to pending registration renewal cases.

(3) The provisions of subtitle 2 shall not apply to cases where the period of registration of a healthcare worker expires between 1 January 2020 and 31 December 2020, provided that the organ keeping the register has, based on a registration renewal application, already renewed it before the entry into force of this Decree.
