

**Government Decree 58/2020 (23 March)**  
**amending Government Decree 41/2020 (11 March) on the measures to be taken**  
**during the state of danger declared for the prevention of the human epidemic**  
**endangering life and property and causing massive disease outbreaks, for the**  
**elimination of its consequences, and for the protection of the health and lives of**  
**Hungarian citizens**

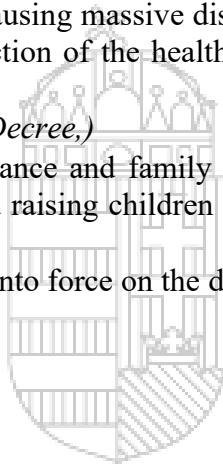
The Government,  
acting within its original legislative power laid down in Article 53 (2) of the Fundamental  
Law,  
acting within its function laid down in Article 15 (1) of the Fundamental Law,  
orders as follows:

**Section 1** In section 4 of Government Decree 41/2020 (11 March) on the measures to be taken during the state of danger declared for the prevention of the human epidemic endangering life and property and causing massive disease outbreaks, for the elimination of its consequences, and for the protection of the health and lives of Hungarian citizens, the following point *d*) shall be added:

*(From the entry into force of this Decree,)*

“*d*) the eligibility for health insurance and family benefits granted under a government decree with regard to caring for and raising children shall be extended until the end of the state of danger,”

**Section 3** This Decree shall enter into force on the day following its promulgation.
