

Government Decree 87/2020 (5 April)

laying down derogations applicable to the payment of waiting fee during the period of state of danger

The Government,
acting within its original legislative power laid down in Article 53 (2) of the Fundamental Law, having regard to the provisions of Act XII of 2020 on the containment of coronavirus,
acting, with respect to section 3, within its original legislative power laid down in Article 53 (3) of the Fundamental Law, on the basis of authorisation by the National Assembly under section 3 (1) of Act XII of 2020 on the containment of coronavirus,
acting within its function laid down in Article 15 (1) of the Fundamental Law,
orders as follows:

Section 1 During the period of state of danger under Government Decree 40/2020 (11 March) on the declaration of state of danger, with a view to reducing the spread of the human epidemic, no waiting fee shall be paid for using for waiting with a vehicle the waiting areas of

- a)* local public roads, and publicly accessible private roads, squares, parks and other public spaces owned by a local government, and
- b)* national public roads, and publicly accessible private roads, squares, parks and other public spaces owned by the State.

Section 2 (1) With the exception specified in paragraph (2), this Decree shall enter into force on the day following its promulgation.

(2) Section 3 shall enter into force on the fifteenth day following the promulgation of this Decree.

Section 3 The Government extends the temporal scope of this Decree until the end of the period of state of danger under Government Decree 40/2020 (11 March) on the declaration of state of danger.
