

Government Decree 588/2021 (20 October)
laying down derogations applicable to certain events held in autumn 2021

The Government,
acting within its original legislative power laid down in Article 53 (2) of the Fundamental Law, having regard to section 51/A of Act CXXVIII of 2011 on disaster management and amending certain related Acts,
acting within its function laid down in Article 15 (1) of the Fundamental Law,
decrees as follows:

Section 1 (1) Government Decree 484/2020 (10 November) on the second phase of protective measures applicable during the period of state of danger (hereinafter “Decree 484/2020”) shall not apply to

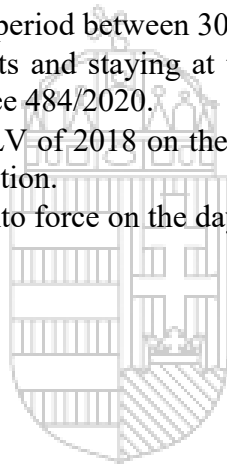
a) state and local government events commemorating the 1956 Revolution and War of Independence held on 22 and 23 October 2021, and

b) state and local government events linked to feasts of religious communities and events held by religious communities in the period between 30 October 2021 and 2 November 2021.

Organising and holding these events and staying at the venue of these events shall not be subject to the restrictions under Decree 484/2020.

(2) Assemblies falling within Act LV of 2018 on the right of assembly shall continue to be allowed to be held without any restriction.

Section 2 This Decree shall enter into force on the day following its promulgation.
