Government Decree 38/2022 (11 February)

extending with regard to the state of danger the validity of certain expired documents

The Government,

acting within its original legislative power laid down in Article 53 (2) of the Fundamental Law, having regard to section 51/A of Act CXXVIII of 2011 on disaster management and amending certain related Acts,

acting, with respect to section 3, within its original legislative power laid down in Article 53 (3) of the Fundamental Law, on the basis of an authorisation by the National Assembly pursuant to section 2 (1) of Act I of 2021 on the containment of the coronavirus pandemic,

acting within its function laid down in Article 15 (1) of the Fundamental Law, decrees as follows:

Section 1 Notwithstanding section 12 (1) of Act CXXX of 2021 on certain regulatory matters related to the state of danger, every identity card, driving licence and passport that expired or expires on 11 March 2020 or thereafter but not later than 31 May 2022 shall be valid until 30 June 2022.

Section 2 (1) With the exception specified in paragraph (2), this Decree shall enter into force on the day following its promulgation.

(2) Section 3 shall enter into force on the fifteenth day following the promulgation of this Decree.
